

The home of the British monarchy and of The King's Gallery: an intimate showcase for the masterpieces of the Royal Collection.




#### TOWER OF LONDON, EC3




#### **BLACK HISTORY WALKS**

#### ST. JAMES'S PARK, SW1






#### WESTMINSTER ABBEY, SW1


#### MINISTRY OF SOUND, SE1
